Several medical shops shut in Karnataka over nationwide-pharmacy protest, strike call gets mixed response

BENGALURU, MAY 20: A nationwide strike call by AIOCD against pharmacies witnessed a mixed response across Karnataka on Wednesday, with several medical shops remaining shut in many districts while a number of pharmacies continued operations.

The shutdown was part of a protest called by the All India Organisation of Chemists and Druggists (AIOCD) against online pharmacies and alleged violations of regulatory norms under the Drugs and Cosmetics Act. In Bengaluru, while many medical shops downed shutters in support of the bandh, several pharmacies continued to serve customers as usual. At Halasuru and some other localities in the city, medical shops were found functioning normally. A staff at Pooja Medicals in Bengaluru's Halasuru area said they were operating as usual and had not received any such intimation from their respective association about the strike. However, the strike saw participation in districts such as Dakshina Kannada, Udipi, Gadag, Tumakuru, Bagalkot and Shivamogga, where many medical stores remained closed through the day.

In Mysuru, some chemists operated their outlets wearing black bands as a mark of protest. The Bruhat Bengaluru Chemists and Druggists Association (BBCDA), however, had earlier clarified that it would not participate in the bandh and that medical shops under its fold would remain open in the interest of the public. "No Bandh will be there on May 20 and shops will continue normal operations. All pharmacy stores will remain open to provide services to the public," it had said in a statement. However, Karnataka Chemists and

Druggists Association (KCDA) president R Raghunatha Reddy claimed that barring a few medical shops, many chemists across the state have participated in the strike.

Reddy said the protest had become unavoidable due to repeated violations of the Drugs and Cosmetics Act by e-pharmacies. "The sale through online pharmacies is not permissible under the Act. We also have High Court orders, but they are not being followed," Reddy said. He also alleged that e-pharmacies were offering heavy discounts, disrupting the regulated margin structure of 16 to 20 per cent and adversely affecting small retailers. Veeranarayana Gowda, the owner of Shri Vinayaka Medicals in Lakkasandra Extension said he had closed his shop at 10.30 pm on Tuesday night and would continue participating in the protest through Wednesday. Explaining the reason behind the protest, Gowda said medicines are a

controlled commodity and cannot be sold like other products.

"There is a fixed margin allowed for retailers and distributors. But online pharmacies are buying medicines in bulk and selling them at heavy discounts, affecting small medical shops," he said. "There is no proper control over online sale of medicines.

Medicines are being supplied without checking prescriptions. In pharmacies, if there is any error in the prescription, we can identify it and ask customers to consult the doctor again," he added. Gowda further said the response to the strike was mixed because multiple chemists' associations operate in the state. "There are several associations. Some associations supported the strike while some did not. That is why some medical shops remained open and others joined the protest," he said.

NEET against state's rights, poor people: TN minister

CHENNAI, MAY 20: Tamil Nadu Health Minister Arun Raj on Wednesday reiterated the government's opposition to NEET, saying it is against state's rights and poor people.

"NEET, we have told repeatedly, we are not for it. We are against NEET. It's against state's rights and against poor people," Dr Raj said on the sidelines of his maiden official review meeting at the Madras Medical College (MMC) here. He further criticised the central implementation of the exam, stating that the government stands firmly against "this oneness creating uniformity in diversity". Raj also emphasised a major shift toward improving patient experience and quality of care in government hospitals. Speaking to PTI Videos, Raj expressed personal pride in returning to his alma mater. "First of all, MMC is my college. I studied medicine from here and I am happy to be here," he said.

Asked about his primary directives to health officials, the Minister underscored that the core mandate of the government is to elevate the "quality of care" given to patients on a war-footing basis. "Ultimately, the end result is the quality of care given to the patients," Dr Raj stated.

"We want to ensure that care and that hospital experience... it's a basic human right.

We want to ensure that people have more faith in government hospitals, come more willingly, and get treatment in a clean environment," he added, urging government doctors to fully cooperate with the new administration's expectations to execute this mandate effectively.

Village head booked over rape charge

SHAHJAHANPUR: A village head allegedly confined and raped a Dalit woman sanitation worker who had gone to his house for signing her salary slip here, police said on Wednesday. Additional Superintendent of Police (City) Devendra Kumar said the alleged incident occurred on May 18. The 40-year-old woman, who was appointed as a sanitation worker on compassionate grounds after the death of her husband, alleged that the village head had called her to his house on the pretext of signing her salary slip, Kumar said. The woman alleged in her complaint that after she reached the house, the accused locked the door, tied her hands and raped her, the officer said.

Hydroponic ganja worth Rs 3 cr seized, 2 held

HYDERABAD: The DRI on Wednesday said it has seized eight kgs of hydroponic ganja worth Rs 3 crore at the international airport here and arrested two persons. Acting on specific intelligence, the officers of DRI, Hyderabad Zonal Unit intercepted two Indian passengers arriving from Bangkok on May 19 at Rajiv Gandhi International Airport. During systematic examination of their check-in baggage, 24 black coloured packets containing greenish, lumpy substance with a sharp, pungent odour was recovered, a DRI release said. The packets were concealed inside insulated water bottles, a potato snack tin, and multiple food tin boxes/plastic/cardboard boxes.

UP: 4 killed as car rams truck on NH-9

AMROHA: Four persons were killed and two others seriously injured after a WagonR car ramed into a truck on National Highway-9 in the Amroha district early Wednesday morning, police said. The accident occurred near Nayara petrol pump at Khyalipur Dhal in the Gajraula police station area around 4 am. Police said the impact of the collision was so severe that the car was badly mangled. Circle Officer Anjali Kataria said the deceased included the car driver Mohammad Salman, a resident of Rampur, and three passengers identified as Naseem, Haris, and Mashooq, all residents of Malda district in West Bengal. According to police, the victims were students of a madrasa in Varanasi and had recently visited Bareilly.

MBA student found dead in Meerut college hostel

MEERUT, MAY 20: A 23-year-old final-year MBA student was found dead on Wednesday morning inside the hostel of a private college in the Ganganagar area here, police said. Preliminary investigations suggest the student may have died after falling from a height, though police said all angles are being probed. The deceased was identified as Anu Gupta, a resident of Saharanpur, who was pursuing her MBA while staying at the Sarojini Naidu Girls' Hostel located within the college campus. According to police, a member of the hostel's cleaning staff spotted Gupta's body lying in the lobby on Wednesday morning and alerted the college administration. She was rushed to a nearby hospital, where doctors declared her dead on arrival. Police officials said the victim had severe facial injuries. She had recently returned to the hostel from her hometown in Saharanpur.
